



Port Wakefield Overpass and Highway Duplication Project Pedestrian Detour Notification

The Port Wakefield Overpass and Highway Duplication Project is jointly funded by the Australian and the South Australian governments and will be delivered by the Port Wakefield to Port Augusta Project (PW2PA) Alliance.

The project will improve traffic flow and reduce congestion for all road users, particularly, during peak travel times and public holidays, and improve safety and freight productivity along the National Land Transport Network.

As part of the project, the PW2PA Alliance advises that pedestrian access between Minnie Street and Phillips Road will be temporarily unavailable while the new southbound lanes on Port Wakefield Highway are being constructed.

Timing of works:

Works are expected to commence in mid-March 2021 and will be completed by end of 2022, weather permitting.

Works will be undertaken during the day (Monday to Saturday) between 7am and 7pm. No works will be undertaken on Sundays or at night, unless otherwise advised.

What to expect:

Pedestrian detours will be available via footpaths on the western side of Port Wakefield Highway, and signage will be in place to alert pedestrians to the change in conditions (see map overleaf).

Access to residential and business properties will be maintained at all times.
