



Port Wakefield Road Upgrade

Night works – traffic barrier relocation and line marking

The \$124.5m Port Wakefield Overpass and Highway Duplication Project is jointly funded by the Australian and the South Australian governments (80:20) and is being delivered by the Port Wakefield to Port Augusta Project (PW2PA) Alliance. The project will improve traffic flow and reduce congestion for all road users, particularly, during peak travel times and public holidays, and improve safety and freight productivity along the National Land Transport Network.

In order to minimise the impact to road users, works will be undertaken at night to relocate traffic barriers and undertake line marking at Port Wakefield.

These works will move progressively along the following two locations:

- Port Wakefield Highway northbound, between Liberty 24 Seven service station and the Wakefield River; and
- southbound, along the newly constructed road to the east of the service stations (see map overleaf).

Timing of works:

Works will be undertaken intermittently at night, between Wednesday, 28 July 2021, and Friday, 13 August 2021, weather permitting. Hours of work are between 7pm and 7am.

What to expect:

Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. The closure and detour at the Port Wakefield Road junction with Balaklava Road will remain in place. Local access for businesses and residents will be maintained.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Existing pedestrian detours will remain in place via footpaths on the western side of Port Wakefield Highway.
