

Joy Baluch AM Bridge Duplication Project

Night Works – Augusta Highway (between Flinders Terrace and Burgoyne Street)

The Joy Baluch AM Bridge is an important link in the National Land Transport Network at Port Augusta, providing access across the Spencer Gulf for commuter, commercial and freight vehicles in the northern region of South Australia. It is also a key tourist connection to the Eyre Peninsula, northern South Australia and beyond.

The \$200 million Joy Baluch AM Bridge Duplication Project is a joint initiative of the Australian and South Australian governments (80:20) and is being delivered by the Port Wakefield to Port Augusta (PW2PA) Alliance.

As the project is nearing completion, the focus has shifted to finishing asphalting, drainage, guardrail and lighting installation works on Augusta Highway, between Flinders Terrace and Burgoyne Street.

To safely facilitate the works and to minimise the impact to road users, **night works** will be undertaken intermittently between **7pm** and **7am** from **Thursday**, **13 April 2023**, until **Wednesday**, **7 June 2023**, **weather permitting**.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible. Advance notice will be provided to residents directly impacted by the night works during these periods.

Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
