

# Joy Baluch AM Bridge Duplication Project

The Joy Baluch AM Bridge is an important link in the National Land Transport Network at Port Augusta, providing access across the Spencer Gulf for commuter, commercial and freight vehicles in the northern region of South Australia. It is also a key tourist connection to the Eyre Peninsula, northern South Australia and beyond.

The \$200 million Joy Baluch AM Bridge Duplication Project is a joint initiative of the Australian and South Australian governments (80:20) and is being delivered by the Port Wakefield to Port Augusta (PW2PA) Alliance.

## What's happening:

Temporary lane restrictions will be in place on the north-bound lanes to safely undertake expansion joint repairs on the original Joy Baluch AM Bridge.

Signage will be in place to alert motorists of temporary changes and speed restrictions.

Some noise could be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbances to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

*This notice does not change previous advice, but provides further clarification for oversized vehicles. Our VMS signs have been updated to include the detour for only 3.5m+/oversized vehicles.*

## How this affects you:

For vehicles travelling north (on the old Joy Baluch AM Bridge) please note the following:




- if your vehicle is **oversized, including loads that are over 3.5m**, you will be required to detour via Yorkeys Crossing (signs will be in place).
- **all other vehicles** will use the bridge, including road trains under 3.5m width. Traffic management onsite will direct you to a single north-bound lane.

For vehicles travelling south (on the new Joy Baluch AM Bridge) there will be no impact.
