



Temporary Road Closure – Moulds Road, Lochiel

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$260 million (80:20) to the Augusta Highway Duplication Project. This includes the duplication of the Augusta Highway from Port Wakefield to Lochiel.

The Augusta Highway is the key road corridor between Port Wakefield and Port Augusta and forms part of the National Land Transport Network, providing crucial connectivity to regional South Australia and interstate.

The project will deliver several key benefits, including safer roads for all users, improved freight efficiency, reduced travel times, and a more reliable road network.

From Monday 3 March 2025, the intersection of Augusta Highway and Moulds Road in Lochiel will be temporarily closed until the end of March 2025.

Detour signage will direct motorists via Blyth and Oval Roads. Please refer to the map provided for additional details

The Augusta Highway will remain open throughout, but there will be speed limits and restrictions near construction areas, especially when workers are present. Drivers should be careful, follow speed limits, lane restrictions, and traffic controller directions.

Once Moulds Road reopens, only left-hand turns will be allowed onto the reconfigured dual carriageway section of Augusta Highway.
